## HOW TO APPLY TO TAFE

International students can choose from more than 100 courses to study at a TAFE college in Western Australia. Visit the online catalogue at [tafeinternational.wa.edu.au/courses](https://tafeinternational.wa.edu.au/courses)

You can apply to study at a TAFE college by completing your application online [tafeinternational.wa.edu.au/apply](https://tafeinternational.wa.edu.au/apply) . This is our preferred method and will receive priority processing.

### TAFE International Western Australia (TIWA)

All international students applying to study at a Western Australian TAFE college must apply through TIWA.

#### Application Checklist



1. Find a course



2. Check entry requirements and prepare your documents



3. Submit your application



4. Accept your offer and pay



5. Receive your Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) and apply for your student visa



6. Receive your visa and make travel arrangements

### Education Agents

Registered TIWA education agents can assist you with your application to study in Western Australia.

The role of an education agent is to provide you with guidance in:

- > choosing your course;
- > completing your application; and
- > applying for your student visa to Australia.
