ENGLISH PACKAGING

When you apply directly to TIWA for a TAFE course, our admissions team will assess whether or not you require an English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students (ELICOS).

Should you need ELICOS, a conditional Letter of Offer outlining the number of weeks required will be issued. While ELICOS is not offered at TIWA, you can package your English studies with one of TIWA's seven partner English language colleges. You simply choose the provider of your choice and contact them directly to organise a packaged offer.

We accept a range of English language tests and evidence of equivalency for entry into our TAFE courses. You can view the specific English admission requirements in our course catalogue at TAFEinternational.wa.edu.au/courses.

RECEIVE OFFER

On receipt of your application and supporting documentation, we will assess your eligibility to study your selected course(s). We will then send you a Letter of Offer provided you meet eligibility requirements for admission and there are places available. This letter will be sent to you either directly or through the agent you have nominated.



RECEIVE YOUR CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT (COE)

After you have met all the conditions, signed the Letter of Acceptance and made payment, you will be issued your CoE. You can then apply for your student visa by visiting the Department of Home Affairs website at [immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-finder/study](https://www.immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-finder/study).



ACCEPT OFFER

To accept your offer you need to sign the Letter of Acceptance and make payment.



MEET CONDITIONS

You are required to meet any conditions listed in your Letter of Offer before accepting the offer and making payment.



START YOUR STUDIES

When your student visa is issued you can make plans to start your studies at TIWA. Before making travel arrangements, check the orientation dates for your campus as you need to arrive in time for orientation. UNIVERSITY PATHWAYS

TIWA offers pathways to some of Australia's leading universities. With a large range of pathway combinations, TIWA offers more study options for students.

WHAT IS A PATHWAY TO UNIVERSITY?

If you would like to study a university degree, and don't have the academic requirements, a TIWA pathway to university can help you reach your education goals.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

TIWA has a number of diploma and advanced diploma courses that can be packaged with bachelor degrees. If eligible, you will receive two offers – from TIWA and from your chosen university. A university pathway allows you to have a planned pathway for study at both vocational and educational training (VET) and university levels. On completion of your TAFE and university studies, you will have two qualifications that will give you a competitive edge in the global job market. Some courses at TAFE have a strong practical component, which is in high industry demand.

UNIVERSITY PATHWAY PACKAGES

TIWA has partnerships with Curtin University, Edith Cowan University, Murdoch University, and Notre Dame University. We can arrange a TAFE to university packaged offer for a wide range of courses. This allows you to apply for one student visa and the university degree will be your principal course.

Please read the following before you apply for a university package.

You must apply through an education agent registered to represent both TIWA and your chosen university.

- » You can package English with your TAFE and university courses, but the duration of your English studies will be limited.
- » You must request the university package at the time you are applying to TIWA.
- » Any advanced standing or credit for recognised learning will be reflected on your university offer.

Please note that information regarding university pathways is correct at the time of printing and may change at any time.

ARTICULATION

If you want to keep your study options open, you can still apply to study at university at a later date. TIWA has a number of diploma and advanced diploma courses that will give you advanced standing or credit for recognised learning once you complete your studies. These credit transfers will be applied when you commence your undergraduate degree studies at university and will vary depending on the course and electives you have completed with TIWA.

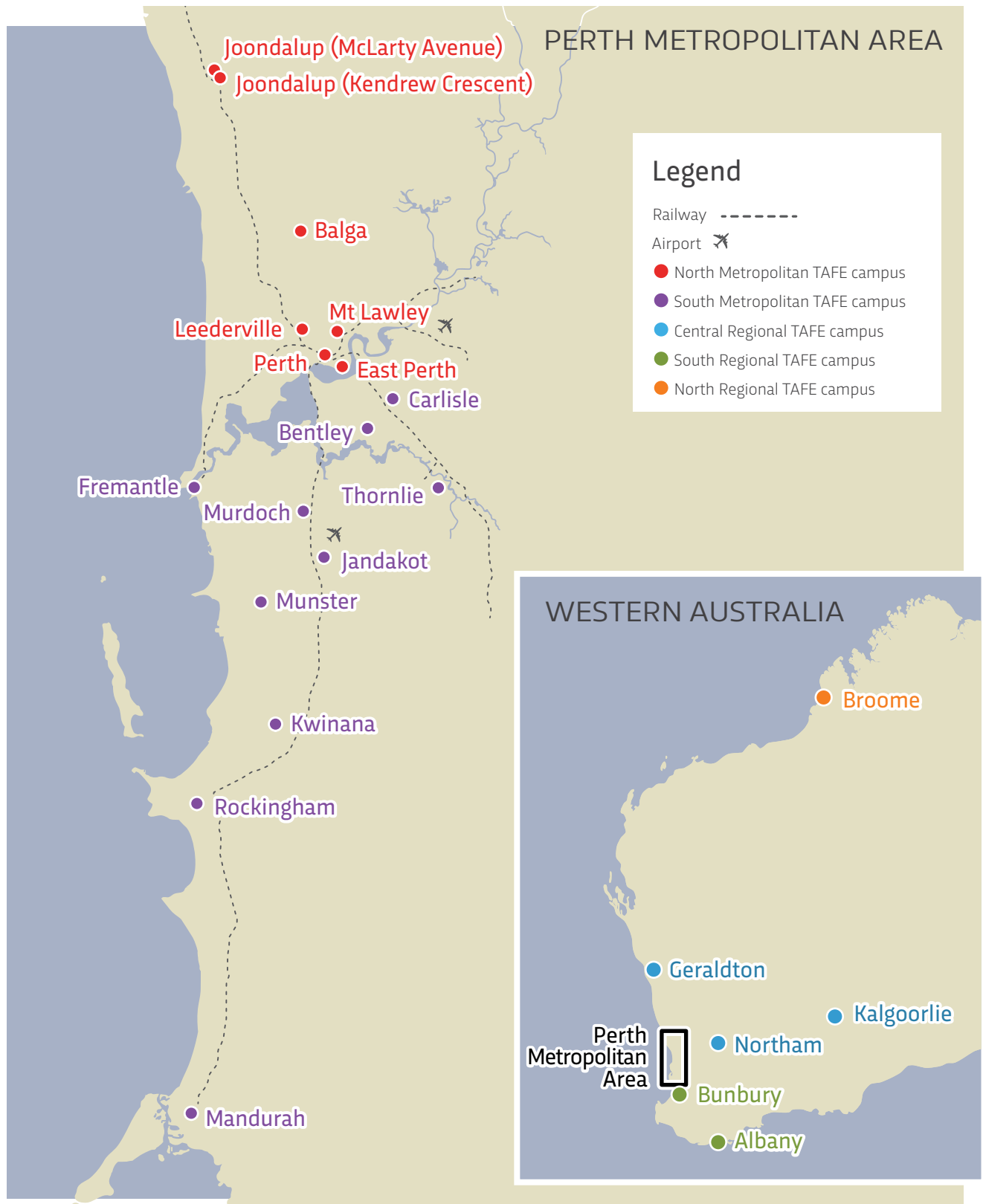

SETTING UP HOME

ARRIVAL

On your arrival in Perth, airport pick-up can be arranged at a cost of AUD\$130. You will be taken directly to your homestay family; temporary accommodation; or your own accommodation.

Please contact Australian Homestay Network (AHN) to organise this service at homestaynetwork.org.

A taxi from the airport to central Perth costs approximately AUD\$50. An airport bus is also available which can drop you at central city hotels.

OVERSEAS HEALTH COVER

As an international student in Australia, the Australian Government requires you to:

- » purchase Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) in order to be granted a student visa;
- » be covered by OSHC for the entire length of your student visa;
- » purchase OSHC from a registered health provider, approved by the Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care; and
- » pay OSHC before you leave home, to cover you from your arrival in Australia.

The Department of Home Affairs website provides detailed information about the health insurance requirements of the Australian Government at immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/help-support/meeting-our-requirements/health/adequate-health-insurance.

You must purchase OSHC from a government approved provider. You should compare alternative OSHC providers to find one that suits your budget and needs. To view more information, please visit our website at TAFEinternational.wa.edu.au/health-cover.

HOMESTAY

Homestay is very popular because you can make friends, embrace the Australian lifestyle and improve your English.

The Australian Homestay Network (AHN) can organise a homestay that will allow you to live with an Australian family. Homestay is compulsory for students under 18 years of age.

Homestay costs AUD\$325 per week for adults; including three meals per day and laundry, snacks, electricity and gas. There is also a homestay placement fee of AUD\$290.
